Protection Technical Programme (CP TP) focus within the ministry. Accordingly, in order to ensure skill building for adolescent, the CP&A will host Impact Plus model of World Vision International (WVI).

Even as the CP Technical Programme (TP) is scheduled to be implemented over 25 Area Programmes (AP), the Technical Specialist – Skills Building (Children and Young Persons) will lead the process in rolling out the Impact Plus project model under the CP TP. The Technical Specialist will direct technical guidance and support to ensure effective implementation of the Impact Plus model across the regions ensuring adequate capacity, focus, innovation and monitoring in the process.

Major Responsibilities

- Develop necessary training material and conduct orientation on the Impact plus model amongst WVL staff.
- Design Impact Plus materials: Ex: Project Implementation guidelines, Monitoring plan, club manuals, curriculum guidelines, journal, etc.
- Direct guidance to support for mentoring and management of Skill Development
 Facilitators (SDF) who are responsible for Impact Plus Clubs at AP level.
- Develop process and support monitor progress of Impact Plus implementation and achievements by APs.
- Initiate efforts to help sustain the effects of impact plus model contribution / Innovate responses to enhance the effectiveness of the project model with in WVL 's ministry.
- Help towards establishing baseline data in an organized fashion to enable evaluation of project's impact.
