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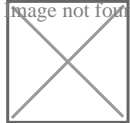

The Flood Recovery Program is a pathway for 'Community owned' Aboriginal Housing Providers to seek funding to repair or rebuild homes, and 'Community owned' buildings that have been affected by flood / storm and severe weather event (AGRN 1012). The Program may be extended to 'Community owned' buildings that support social cohesion.

Community Housing Flood Recovery (CHFR) Projects must meet the following eligibility criteria to be considered for this Program:

- Applicants must be a registered provider, or partnered with a registered provider, or transitional registration can be granted for eligible Aboriginal Housing Providers for the duration of the project.
- Assets must be 'Community owned', being owned by Aboriginal Housing Providers including Local Aboriginal Land Councils (LALC's), Aboriginal Corporations (AC's) and or Aboriginal Community Housing Providers (ACHP's).
- Projects must be repair, rebuild or construction of Community owned social housing or Community owned buildings that play a key role in social cohesion.

- Assets must be located in an eligible Local Government Areas including Ballina, Byron, Clarence Valley, Lismore, Richmond Valley, Tweed and Kyogle. The potential inclusion of additional, neighbouring LGAs, will be considered as damage assessments are undertaken.
- Assets must have been directly impacted by event AGRN 1012 - NSW Severe Weather and Flooding: 22 February 2022 onwards.
- A list of affected properties / assets will need to be submitted through this Expression of Interest (EOI) process to be considered.
- Evidence of the impact of flood or severe weather conditions required to determine eligibility.
