# **PURPOSE OF POSITION**

The primary purpose of the position of the Monitoring and Communications Officer is to:

- 2. Serve as a communications business partner to the zonal office.
- 3. Ensure availability of programmatic data and communications content in World Vision's system to be used by World Vision for reporting and external engagement.

- 2. Ensure quality of data, including appropriate disaggregation, to enable AP measurement and a view of programming as it relates to girls and boys, men and women as well as the most vulnerable children.
- 3. Ensure all data is recorded in a timely manner in relevant systems.
- Analyze trends and conduct other analyses under the direction of the ELA Manager
- Measure and report on programme progress to Evidence, Learning and Accountability (ELA) Manager, relevant Zonal Manager and Operations Director.
- Facilitate zonal-level, lessons-learned discussions based on monitoring data, analysis and other results.
- 7. Support CESC officers in collecting and analyzing child participation data as well as in provision of information and facilitation/documentation of learning during Communication Engagement and



Annual Planning (CEAP).

- 8. Support technical staff in the design and administration of pre- and post-tests.
- Support assessment, baseline, and evaluation processes at the direction of the ELA Manager

#### Communications

- Actively share information and coordinate with the Communications Specialist. (matrix manager)
- Advise on use of World Vision's brand guidelines to ensure all activities align with prioritized, approved World Vision JWG messages and branding guidelines for consistent public engagement.
- Actively produce content, taking photos and videos of activities in the field in alignment with the external engagement plan. Edit and produce videos as skills allow or manage local consultants/contributors.
- Fulfill specific content requests made by the Communications Specialist to help World Vision JWG fulfill its overall external



engagement strategy.

- 5. Write compelling stories (or propose ideas to the Communications Specialist) that make use of both data from programmes and compelling human interest. Use child voice and participation where possible.
- Support and contribute to national level publications.
- 7. Organize zonal level events and help with national level events in consultation with the Zonal Manager and Communications Specialist and in alignment with the national office's overall external engagement plan, which includes It Takes a World.
- Work with the Communications Specialist to identify and line-up media to participate in World Vision JWG events.
- Ensure external presentations are of high quality and align with World Vision's contextualised branding.
- Serve as a local spokesperson, when required.
- Know emergency communications standards and protocols. Provide
