This position is responsible for developing and implementing Grant / Corporate Partnerships Communications plan in alignment with WVL's strategy.

Major Responsibilities

- Develop and deliver on an Annual Grant / Corporate Partnerships Communications strategy and a business plan which support IRDM and Corporate Partnerships
 Departments' communications needs and prepositioning of the projects and raising of their profiles.
- Develop material such as Fact sheets / Reports / Capacity Statement that helps the prepositioning of these projects and the raising of their profiles.
- Amplify country-level initiatives and messages, for a greater share of voice and impact while increasing the level of recognition and positive perception of WVL.
- Coordination with local media and PE leads to position grant and corporate partnerships initiatives, within the partnership and externally.
- Work closely with the field Project and Area Programme teams to generate high quality content.
- Undertake rapid deployment to disaster zones if / as required to produce quality stories and photos for WVL and the donor audiences.
