The Technical Specialist will be responsible for providing guidance for the implementation of the ReSoCo Project Model in selected Area/ Cluster Programme of World Vision Lanka (WVL). ReSoCo aims to provide strengths and core human values to reinforce social cohesion and



resilience among Young Individuals in collaboration with communities, government & other stakeholders and likeminded organizations. ReSoCo provides training for the youth to enhance their ability to focus on the development of a culture of peace and collaboration through learnt skills. ReSoCo further intends to enable youth and the communities to reflect on the values, attitudes and competencies that help develop peace, equality, dignity, belonging and wellbeing and to develop mechanisms to transfer these values to others. This project model promotes diversity, non-discrimination, and inclusion among youth. The role of this position targets facilitate to build capacity of Youth, Community and Partners to implement activities that support the youth to acquire insight on their values, and to develop knowledge and awareness on the importance of social cohesion and life skills that will elevate their positive living values such as responsibility, peace, love, honesty, humility, cooperation, respect and perseverance which makes them employable and productive.

- Provide technical guidance to Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability & learning (MEAL)
 to conduct appraisals of impact against baseline data
