The purpose of this position is to coordinate 2 critical aspects of the GIZ funded programme multiyear and multi Donor funded programme: Green Center operations and the Litter Picking (LP) new component in Azraq camp by managing 2 Green Centre supervisors, LP Field Coordinator and overall management of 11 - 12 staff, as well as to coordinate the commercial part of the intervention with the SCM Department. and will play a significant role in the leasing with local authorities to prepare the ground for future handover of SWM activities to the local government.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITES:

- Managing performance of the extended team (3 direct managerial lines and overall
- 11-15 team members in the camp)
- Support day to day and weekly targets of the project Admin/finance officer including the data entry team in coordination with PM.
- Oversee the Green Centre and Litter Picking components of the operation in the camp.



- Acting as an PM OIC when needed
- Support with camp actors and local government the SWM operations in the camp along with the PM.
- Contribute in WASH strategies development both at organizational and at the camp WASH sector levels.
- coordinate the operation cash flow and budget for certain activities and upon PM request.
- Oversee the commercial component of the programme to increase the recovery percentage of recyclable materials.
- Oversee the operation maintenance and provide an effective solution in coordination with SCM.
- Apply innovative solutions to enhance the effectiveness of operations from
- engineering and operational perspectives
- Coordinate Green Center related construction, procurement and logistic needs/issues with respective departments
