C	Qualifying requirements of contractors/ tenderers containing the following: -
(i)	<p>Agency should have satisfactorily completed (Phase / Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted) three works, each of Rs.1.98 Lakhs (excluding GST) or two works, each of Rs. 2.48 Lakhs (excluding GST) or one work of Rs.3.96 Lakhs (excluding GST) in single contract of similar nature of work "AMC of fire alarm, fire detection and fire fighting system" during last seven years ending on the last or extended date of submission of tender.</p> <p>The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid.</p> <p><u>The experience certificates of works completed pre-GST era, completion amount will be divided by 1.12 (to exclude pre-GST tax of VAT 12%) to make it at par with experience certificates of post GST era but excluding GST.</u></p>
(ii)	Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. Firms showing work experience certificate from Non-Government/ Non-PSU Organizations should submit copy of Tax Deduction at Source [TDS] Certificate along with a certificate issued by registered Chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.



(iii)	Agency should have annualized average financial turnover of Rs. 1.49 Lakhs against works executed during last three years ending 31 st March of the previous financial year. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Firms showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
(iv)	The tenderer should have a minimum net worth of Rs.0.74 Lakhs issued by certified Chartered Accountant. (As per the format at Page no. PR-06.)
(v)	Should possess valid Electrical Contractors' License.
(vi)	Tenderers have to submit UDIN generated documents i.e. Balance sheet, Turnover certificate, Net worth Certificate, Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) Certificates for Non-Govt. works etc. per NIT conditions duly certified by CA and having UDIN. The documents submitted by bidder without UDIN shall not be entertained.
(vii)	Firm shall submit EPF and ESIC registration certificate. In case, firm do not possess the EPF & ESIC registration, firm is required to submit the undertaking regarding getting themselves registered with EPF & ESI authorities, if becomes L-1 before commencement of work.
(viii)	In Addition to the above Prequalification criteria documents, bidder have to submit the Undertaking for GST as per format at Page no. PR-03 of tender document. The L-1 bidder have to submit the duly notarized affidavit regarding compliance of minimum wages on Non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- or higher value as per page no. PR-05 , if become L-1, before commencement of work.
(ix)	Scanned copy of all the Documents of Envelope-I mentioned above shall be submitted online on the CPP portal. Any documents in any other mode shall not be accepted.
D	<u>Envelope-II: - The Financial e-Bid through CPP Portal.</u>
(i)	All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of tenderer). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the file name. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected
(ii)	The tenderers shall submit their application only at CPP portal https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/appc . Tenders are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.
E	<u>BIDS OPENING PROCESS: -</u>
(i)	Envelope-I: -Envelope I Containing Documents as per para 8 (A), (B) and (C) (Uploaded by the bidders) shall be opened as per CRITICAL DATASHEET. The intimation regarding acceptance / rejection of their bids will be intimated to the contractors/ firms through CPP portal.
(ii)	If any clarification is needed from the bidder about the deficiency in uploaded documents in Envelope I, he will be asked to provide it through "Short Fall Documents" folder on CPP Portal. The bidder shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by AAI, failing which tender will be liable for rejection



(iii)	Envelope- II: -The Financial Bids of the Contractors / Firms found to be meeting the qualifying requirements and technical criteria shall be opened as per CRITICAL DATA SHEET.
(iv)	AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.
(v)	AAI reserve the right to disallow issue of tender document to working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/ Temporary/ Permanent debar by any department of AAI or central/State Govt. Dept /PSUs/World Bank/ADB etc. AAI reserve the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information /documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect / false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the firm then AAI shall take the following action: The agency shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, apart from any other appropriate contractual / legal action.
