NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER (2 BOT – 2 ENVELOPE OPEN TENDER) (e-Tender ID: 2022_AAI_113654_1)

1. Item Rate e-tenders are invited through the e-tendering CPP Portal by Asst. General Manager (E-E), Airports Authority of India, Dibrugarh Airport, Dibrugarh - 786012, on behalf of Chairman, AAI from the eligible contractors for the work of "Operation and Maintenance of E & M Installations of Terminal Building and City Side Area at Dibrugarh Airport." at an estimated cost of Rs. 1,53,45,184.00 (Excluding GST) with completion period of 24 (Twenty Four) Months.

The tendering process is online at CPP portal URL address https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app. Prospective Tenderers may download and go through the tender document.

Prospective Tenderers are advised to get themselves register at CPP portal, obtain 'Login ID' and 'Password' and go through the instructions available in the Home Page after log in to the CPP portal https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app. They should also obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in parallel which is essentially required for submission of their application. The process normally takes 03 days time. The tenderer may also take guidance from AAI Help Desk Support through path aai.aero/tender/e-tender/help desk support.

ONLINE PAYMENT OF TENDER PROCESSING FEE & EMD:

- i. Tender processing fee of **Rs. 1,180.00** (i/c GST), non-refundable shall be paid online through payment gateway in CPP Portal only, payable to Airports Authority of India payable at New Delhi. The tenderer, whose Tender Fee is not received, then their Tender will be liable to be rejected.
 - Agencies having valid MSME Certificate (on the date of applying) will be eligible for exemption from Tender Processing Fee. Agency has to upload copy of MSME Certificate in CPPP Website with other required document to avail exemption.
- ii. EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) of the value of **Rs. 3,06,904.00** shall be paid online through payment gateway in CPP Portal only, payable to Airports Authority of India payable at New Delhi. The tenderer, whose EMD is not received, then their Tender will be liable to be rejected.
- iii. The option of **Online Mode** for collection of Tender Processing Fee, EMD has been allowed on CPP Portal, so that the bidders can deposit fee through **Net Banking** (SBI and Other Banks) and **NEFT/RTGS**.
- iv. State Bank of India (SBI) has been authorized as a Nodal Bank and its payment gateway has been integrated/mapped with CPP Portal for the collection of Tender Processing Fee through e-procurement portal from various bidders participating in e-Tendering/e-Procurement process.

C. Qualifying requirements of contractors / tenderers containing the following:

Work experience certificate: The agency should have satisfactorily completed work (# Phase/ Part Completion of the Scope of Work in a Contract shall not be considered. However pre-determined Phasing of the Work will be accepted) of similar nature of work i.e. "Operation & Maintenance of E&M Installations and electrical supply" during last seven years ending on 31.03.2022 as stipulated in table below:

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid i.e. 13.05.2022.

Client Certificate for Experience should show the Nature of Work done, the Value of Work done, Date of Start and Date of Completion as per Agreement, Actual Date of Completion and Satisfactory Completion of Work.

Tenderers showing Work Experience Certificate from Non-Government/ Non-PSU Organizations should submit copy of Tax Deduction at Sources (TDS) Certificates (FORM 26AS) along with a certificate issued by registered charter accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.

ii) Annual Turnover Details: The Agency should have annualized Average Financial Turnover of Rs. 46,03,555.00 against works executed during Last Three Years ending 31st March of the previous financial year.

As a proof, Copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the tenderer should be submitted along with the application.

Tenderers showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.

iii) <u>Certificate of Net Worth</u>: The tenderer should have minimum net worth of **Rs. 23,01,778.00** issued by certified Charted Accountant (**Annexure-E**).

The certificates issued / undertaken / signed by Chartered Accountant towards Annual Turnover and Net worth as stipulated above, should have / consist Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

Tenderers have to submit UDIN generated documents like Balance Sheet / Turnover Certificate, Net worth Certificate, Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) Certificate for Non-Govt. works etc. as per NIT conditions duly certified by Chartered Accountant and having UDIN. The documents submitted by bidders without UDIN shall not be entertained.

Refund of EMD:

The refund of EMD to tenderers, who fail to qualify in the eligibility / technical criteria, shall be initiated within 7 days of their rejection. For all tenderers who qualify, and their financial bids are opened, the refund of EMD of all such tenderers except L-1 shall be processed within 7 days of opening of the financial bid.

Envelope-II: -The Financial e-Bid through CPP Portal.

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the tenderers. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the blue colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the tenderer). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the tenderer should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the tenderer, the bid will be rejected.

3. Bid Submission:

The tenderer shall submit their application only at CPP Portal: https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app Tenderer/ Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as per Para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.

- 4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son (s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/ director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
- 5. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app shall not tamper/ modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/ modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing

business with AAI.

6. Bids Opening Process is as below:

Envelope-I (Tender Processing Fee, EMD, Technical bid and Pre-qualification):

Envelope-I containing documents as per Para 2 (A), (B) and (C) (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET.

If the bidder has any query related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use 'Seek Clarification' on CPP Portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regards shall be entertained.

If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope - I, he will be asked to provide it through **CPP Portal or email,** if required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/ documents within time specified by AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that bidder does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly.

The intimation regarding acceptance/ rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP Portal.

Envelope-II (Financial Bid):

Envelope-II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET. (In case the date and time for opening of Envelope-II (Financial bid) is required to be changed, the same shall be intimated through CPP Portal).

- 7. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 8. AAI reserves the right to disallow the working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary or Permanent debarment/black listing by any department of AAI or Central /State Govt. Depts./PSUs/World Bank/ ADB etc. AAI reserves the right to verify the credential submitted by the tenderer at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information/ documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/ false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the tenderer then AAI shall take the following action:
 - a) Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the tenderer.
 - b) The tenderer shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual/legal action.
- 9. Consortium/ JV companies shall not be permitted.
- 10. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.

- 11. The provisions of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017 dated 15^{th} June, 2017 as amended on 16^{th} September 2020 is applicable for the tenderers.
- 12. Submission of a Bid by bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope of the works to be done and of conditions, local conditions and other factors bearing on the works.
