NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER

1. Item rate(s) tenders are invited through the e-tendering portal by Asst. General Manager (Engg. -E), AAI, old HAL Airport, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560017, Tel.No. 080-25229861 (Bid Manager) on behalf of Chairman, A.A.I. from the Eligible contractors/firms for the work **“Replacement of Conventional type Mandatory Guidance sign boards to LED system at Mysuru Airport”** at an estimated cost of **Rs. 7,48,524/-** (Excluding GST,) with period of completion **03 Months**.

2. The tendering process is online at e-portal URL address www.etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.aai.aero .Aspiring bidders may go through the tender document by login the CPP portal.

Prospective Tenderers are advised to get themselves register at CPP-Portal, obtain 'Login ID' & 'Password' and go through the instruction available in the Home page after log in to the CPP-Portal www.etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.aai.aero. They should also obtain Digital Signature which is essentially required for submission of their applications. The process normally takes 03 days' time the tenderer may also take guidance from AAI Help Desk Support through path aai.aero/tender/e-tender/help Desk Support.

Envelope-I: (EMD, Technical Bid and Pre-qualification):- Bid containing following: -

A. Tender processing fee, EMD: -

1. Tender fee of Rs.1120/- (i/c GST) is required to be paid online only through payment gateway provided at the CPP portal itself.
 2. EMD value of Rs. 14,970/- shall be accepted only through the payment gateway integrated for the purpose with CPP portal.
- (i) Scanned copy of receipt of payment of Tender fee & EMD.

Note: EMD in the form of cash/Demand Draft or any other form shall not be accepted. Vendors shall also note that they are not required to contact any AAI employee or submit any documentary evidence of submission of EMD via Bank Transfer during the process of tender. In no scenario the vendors are required to submit / contact any AAI employees for physical submission of any documents before opening of the bids.

The tenders of the bidders who fail to submit the EMD before the stipulated time shall be rejected outright.

B. Technical Bid containing the following: -

1. Scanned copy of Unconditional Acceptance of AAI's Tender conditions. (Performa given as per Annexure-I).
2. Scanned copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) and GST Registration Certificate.
3. Scanned copy of 'Undertaking' regarding Blacklisting/ Debarment on Company's Letter Head (Performa given on Annexure -II).
4. Scanned copy of GST 'Undertaking' on firm letterhead (Performa given on Annexure III)
5. Companies other than proprietary firm shall submit, scanned copy of Authorization letter/ power of attorney along with copy of certificate of Incorporation of the company under Companies Act showing CIN/LLPIN/Name of Directors of the Company & Copy of Board Resolution regarding Authority of assign Power of Attorney. Proprietary firm shall submit scanned copy of Authorization letter/ Power of Attorney only, if the tender is processed by a person other than proprietor.
6. PQ Performa duly filled.
7. Valid Electrical license.



C. **Qualifying requirements of contractors / tenderer** containing the following:

Agency Should have satisfactorily completed (#Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, **however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted**) three works, each of **Rs. 2.99 Lakhs** or two works each of **Rs 3.74 Lakhs** or one work of **Rs. 5.99 Lakhs** in single contract of similar nature of work **“SITC of LED sign boards at operational area”** during last seven years ending on last date or extended date of submission of bid.

“The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid.

Client certificate for experiences should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. **Tenderers showing work experience certificate from non-government/non PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources (TDS) certificate(s) along with a certificate issued by registered Chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.**

- (i) Should have annualized average financial turnover of **Rs. 2.25 Lakhs** against works executed during last three years ending 31st March of 2021. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the tenderer should be submitted along with the application. Tenderers showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
- (ii) The tenderers should have a minimum net worth of **Rs. 1.12 Lakhs** issued by certified Chartered Accountants. (Performa given on **Annexure IV** of Tender Document). Scanned copy of all the Documents of Envelope-I mentioned above shall be submitted on the CPP Portal. EMD of the value of as per Annexure-A Shall be accepted online in the form of online payment in CPP portal.

Refund of EMD

The refund of EMD to tenderers who fail to qualify in the eligibility / technical criteria, shall be initiated online. For all tenderers who qualify and their financial bids are opened, their EMD of all such tenderers, except L-1, shall be refunded to their source account.

Envelope-II (The Financial e-Bid through CPP Portal): -

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the tenderers. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the blue colored (unprotected) cells with the irrespective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the tenderers). No other cells should be changed. Once the details I completed, the tenderers should save it and submit it online, without changing the file name. If the BOQ file is found modified by the tenderers, the bid will be rejected.



1. Bid Submission:-

The tenderers shall submit their application only at CPP Portal: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tenderers/ Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as per Para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned documents. Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.

2. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/ director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of the condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
3. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>, shall not tamper/ modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with AAI.

4. Bid Opening Process is as below: -

Envelope-I (Tender processing fee, EMD, Technical Bid and pre qualification):

Envelope-I containing documents as per para 2 (A), (B) (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in Critical Data Sheet.

If the bidder has any query related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use 'Seek Clarification' on CPP Portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regard shall be entertained. If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope-I, he will be asked to provide through CPP Portal or email if required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that bidder does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly. The intimation regarding acceptance /rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP Portal.

Envelope-II (Financial Bid):

Envelope-II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time mentioned in Critical Data Sheet.

5. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.



6. AAI reserve the right to disallow the working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary/Permanent debarment/ black listing by any department of AAI or central/ State Govt. Depts. / PSUs/ World Bank/ ADB etc.
 7. AAI reserve the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information/documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect / false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the firm then AAI shall take the following action.
 - a) Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the tenderer.
 - b) **The** agency shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual / legal action.
 8. Consortium / JV companies shall not be permitted. No single firm shall be permitted to submit two separate applications.
 9. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
 10. Concessions to Indian Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) units will not be applicable for this work.
 11. **Tenderers have to submit UDIN generated documents like Balance Sheet/Turnover certificate, Working Capital Certificate (works done during last 5 financial years & works in hand), Net worth Certificate, Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) Certificates for Non-Govt. works etc. as per NIT conditions duly certified by CA and having UDIN. The documents submitted by bidders without UDIN shall not be entertained.**
