1. Item Rate e-tenders are invited through the e-tendering CPP portal by Asst. General Manager Engg (Elect), AAI, Tuticorin Airport, Tuticorin – 628 103. [Tel No. 0461-2272012] on behalf of Chairman, AAI from the eligible contractors for the work of "Provision of Solar Powered Obstruction Light atop of Vallanadu hill at Tuticorin Airport. SH-I: Electrical Works" at an estimated cost of Rs.5.22 Lakhs with completion period of 03 (Three Months).

The tendering process is online at CPP-portal URL address https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.aai.aero. Prospective Tenderers may download and go through the tender document.

Prospective Tenderers are advised to get themselves register at CPP-portal, obtain 'Login ID '&'Password' and go through the instructions available in the Home Page after log in to the CPP-portal https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.aai.aero. They should also obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in parallel which is essentially required for submission of their application. The process normally takes 03 days' time. The tenderer may also take guidance from AAI Help Desk Support through path aai.aero/tender/e-tender/help desk support.

B. Technical Bid containing the following: -

- i) Scanned copy of Unconditional Acceptance of AAI's Tender Conditions.
- ii) Agency should have valid Electrical License.
- iii) Scanned copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) and GST Registration Number.
- iv) Scanned copy of 'Undertaking' regarding Blacklisting / Debarment on Company's Letter Head. (Appendix A)
- v) Scanned copy of ESI & EPF registration copy or an undertaking in company's letter head that the concern will register with ESIC / EPF on award of work. (Appendix-B)
- vi) Should possess documentary proof of owning and possessing required machinery and T&P shall also be submitted along with the application. Ownership can be either freehold or lease hold. In case agency do not have their own or possess required plant and machinery, an undertaking to this effect that the same shall be provided either by purchase or lease hold basis if work is awarded to them, to be submitted along with the application and deployment shall be as per requirement at site decided by the Engineer In-Charge. (Appendix-C)
- vii) Digitally signed Tender document.
- viii)Companies other than proprierty firm shall submit, scanned copy of Authorization Letter / Power of Attoney along with copy of Certificate of Incorporation of the Company under Compains Act showing CIN /LLPIN / Name of Directors of the Company & copy of Board Resolution regarding Authority to assign power of Attorney.
- ix) PQ proforma dully filled (Appendix-D)

Proprietary firm shall submit scanned copy of Authorization Letter/power of Attorney only if the tender is processed by a person other than proprietor.

- C. Qualifying requirements of contractors / tenders containing the following: -
- (i) Should have satisfactorily completed (# Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted) three works, each of Rs.2.46 Lakhs or two works, each of Rs.3.08 Lakhs or one work of Rs.4.93 Lakhs in single contract of similar nature of work i.e. Internal/ External Electrification Works during last seven years ending on 31.05.2022.

"The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7.00% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid". i.e. 10.06.2022"



Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. Tenderers showing work experience certificate from non-government/non-PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources (TDS) certificate (s) alongwith a certificate issued by registered Chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.

- (ii) Should have annualized average financial turnover of **Rs. 1.84 Lakhs** against works executed during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Tenderers showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
- (iii) The tenderer should have a minimum net worth of **Rs.0.92 Lakhs** issued by certified Chartered Accountants. (**Appendix E**)

Refund of EMD

The refund of EMD to tenderers who fail to qualify in the eligibility/technical criteria, shall be done through online mode with immediate effect upon their rejection. For all tenderers who qualify and their financial bids are opened, the refund of EMD of all such tenderers except L-1 shall be processed through online with immediate effect.

Envelope-II: - The Financial e-Bid through CPP portal.

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the tenderers. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the blue coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the tenderer). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the tenderer should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the tenderer, the bid will be rejected.

3. Bid Submission: -

The tenderer shall submit their application only at CPP portal https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as per para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.



- 4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s) /director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
- 5. Tender who has downloaded the tender from central public procurement portal (CPPP) website http://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app,shall tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tender is liable to be banned from doing business with AAI.

6. Bids Opening Process is as below: -

Envelope-I (Tender processing fee, EMD, Technical bid and Prequalification):

Envelope I containing documents as per Para 2 (A), (B)& (C), (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET.

If the bidder has any quary related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use 'Seek Clarification' on CPP portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regards shall be entertained.

If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope-I, he will be asked to provide it through CPP portal or email if required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that bidder does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly.

The intimation regarding acceptance/rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP Portal.

Envelope-II (Financial Bid):

Envelope II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET. (In case the date and time for opening of Envelope-II (Financial bid) is required to be changed, the same shall be intimated through CPP Portal).

7. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.



- 8. AAI reserve the right to disallow the working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary or Permanent debarment/black listing by any department of AAI or Central/State Govt. Depts./PSUs/World Bank/ADB etc. AAI reserves the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information /documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the tenderer then AAI shall take the following action:
- a) Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the tenderer.
- b) The tenderer shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual/legal action.
- 9. Consortium /JV companies shall not be permitted.
- 10. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
- 11. Concession to INDIAN Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) units registered with DIC/NSIC/KVIC/Directorate off Handicraft and Handloom etc. to be given as per the provision of the public procurement policy for MSEs order 2012 with upto date amendments shall be applicable for tenders of supply / services and shall not be extended to construction works.
