- 1. Item Rate e-tenders are invited through the e-tendering CPP Portal by Asst. General Manager [Engg-Elect], Airports Authority of India, Southern Region, Operational Offices, Chennai Airport, Chennai 600 016 on behalf of Chairman, A.A.I from the eligible contractors for the work of "Replacement of AHUs (Phase-I, 8 Nos) of ATS Complex, Southern Region, Chennai Airport. SH: SITC of Split type AC units." at an estimated cost of Rs.14,69,991.00 (Excl GST @ 18%) with completion period of 03 (Three) Months.
- 2. The tendering process is online at CPP-portal URL address https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.aai.aero, Prospective Tenderers may download and go through the tender document.

xi Should have satisfactorily completed work (# Phase/ Part Completion of the Scope of Work in a Contract shall not be considered. However predetermined Phasing of the Work will be accepted) as stipulated in table below.

"The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7%

per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid".

- xii Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work.

 Tenderers showing work experience certificate from non-government / non PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources (TDS) certificate(s) along with a certificate issued by registered Chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.
- xiii Should have annualized average financial turnover of **Rs.4,40,997/-** (Excluding GST) against works executed during last three years ending **31**st **March2021**. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Tenderers showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
- xiv The tenderer should have a minimum net worth of **Rs.2,20,499** /- (Excluding GST) issued by certified chartered accountants(**Annexure E).**

Scanned copy of all the Documents of Envelope-I mentioned above shall be submitted on the CPP Portal. Tender processing fees is required to be submitted only online. The tenderer, whose tender processing fee are not received, then their tenderer will be liable to be rejected.

Refund of EMD

The refund of EMD to tenderers who fail to qualify in the eligibility / technical criteria and for all tenderers who qualify and their financial bids are opened, the refund of EMD of all such tenderers shall be processed as per Refund and Settlement process of Tender fee and EMD.

EMD of unsuccessful bidders received through bank transfer mode (RTGS / NEFT) shall be refunded online through the same mode only and it shall be refunded in the Bank Account whose details are provided on the portal at the time of submission of the tender.

Envelope-II:- The Financial e-Bid through CPP portal.

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the tenderers. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the blue coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the tenderer). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the tenderer should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the tenderer, the bid will be rejected.

4. Bid Submission:-

The tenderer shall submit their application only at CPP Portal: https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instructions provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.

- 5. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
- 6. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app, shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with AAI.

7. Bids Opening Process is as below:-

Envelope-I (Tender processing Fee, Technical bid and Pre-qualification): Envelope-I containing documents as per para 2 (A), (B) and (C) (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET.

If the bidder has any query related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use 'Seek Clarification' on CPP portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regards shall be entertained.

If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope-I, he will be asked to provide it through CPP portal or email if required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that bidder does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly. The intimation regarding acceptance/rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP portal.

Envelope-II (Financial Bid):

Envelope-II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time

mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET. (In case the date and time for opening of Envelope-II (Financial bid) is required to be changed, the same shall be intimated through CPP Portal).

- 8. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserve the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 9. AAI reserves the right to disallow the working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary or Permanent debarment/black listing by any department of AAI or Central/State Govt. Depts./PSUs/World Bank/ADB etc. AAI reserves the right to verify the credential submitted by the tenderer at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information/documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the tenderer then AAI shall take the following action:
 - a) Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the tenderer.
 - b) The tenderer shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual/legal action.
- 10. Consortium/JV companies shall not be permitted.
- 11. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
- 12. Concessions to Indian Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) units registered with DIC/NSIC/KVIC/KVIB/Intectorate of Handicraft and Handloom etc., to be given as partial provisions of Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order 2012 with up to date amendments, shall be applicable for tenders of supply/services and shall not be extended to construction work.
