The Government of Mozambique (GoM) hereinafter referred to as "the Borrower" have received the Grant funds from International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Power Efficiency and Reliability Improvement Project (PERIP). The funds have been channeled through the national Power Utility, Electricidade de Moçambique, E.P. (EDM) as the Project Implementation Agency and EDM intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services;
2. The consulting services ("the Services") include a lump-sum contract for IT Infosec baseline assessment, plan, strategy and licenses for EDM, whose total estimated level of effort of One Project Director and One Security Specialist is 10 person-months, over a period of six (6) months;

4. The Electricidade de Moçambique now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: (i) at least eight (8) years of experience in Cybersecurity Project management (ii) Certified in conducting Cybersecurity Penetration Tests and at least two recommendation letters from the organizations that have used or are using similar services from the Consultant (iii) Provided similar services within African context in the last five (5) years (iv) Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage;

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, November 2020 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest;
6. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected;
7. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the QCBS - Quality and Cost-Based Selection method set out in the Procurement Regulations;
