## Tender Details

TfNSW is seeking to engage a suitable contractor to undertake the paving works of existing Narooma Breakwater Bay to improve the pedestrian track and visual amenity for local/tourist community.

The proposed scope of works consists of, but is not limited to:

- Install site exclusion barriers; these will be placed at the entrance of each Breakwater. The works will be carried out one Breakwater at a time, and stakeholders will be notified before the works begin.
- Confirm the compartment rocks are in the correct position. Any found to be misplaced will be maneuvered into the correct position before any subgrade works are carried out.
- Level the existing subgrade and confirm its suitability before installing the asphalt layer. This operation is done using a small excavator and truck.
- Remove any identified soft areas and replace with a conforming road base, any materials that are removed will be disposed of in licenced waste facilities. All imported materials will also have a conforming certificate.
- On completion of the subgrade, lay 50mm asphalt layer over the subgrade using a paving machine and by hand, compact the asphalt using a small roller and hand-operated compactors.
- Finally, place a D50 rock layer between the edges of the new asphalt and the compartment rock.
