Provision of Gardening and Grounds Maintenance Services At Government House

The Isle of Man Government invites expressions of interest from suitably qualified and experienced gardeners to provide Gardening and Grounds Maintenance Services at Government House, Onchan.

The Cabinet Office are looking to appoint a suitably qualified contractor to provide a full range of gardening services and grounds maintenance at Government House from 1 October 2022. The successful contractor will be required to work to the exacting standards required for the upkeep of a prestigious estate.

Interested contractors must be able to demonstrate capability and experience to provide the services. References for carrying out similar work will be required. The successful contractor shall be a registered member of Construction Isle of Man (prior to contract signature) and be certified under the National Plant Operators Registration Scheme or similar.

In order to participate in this competitive exercise, your organisation must be registered on the Isle of Man Government's Procurement Portal. If you have not previously registered, please visit <https://in-tendhost.co.uk/iomg/asp/Home> and select 'Register' from the menu on the right side of the Home Page.

Once you have registered your organisation you should select this tender from the list of 'Current Tenders' and 'View Details' then click 'Express Interest' at the bottom of the page. Once you have clicked on 'Express an Interest' a 'Form of Acknowledgement' tab will appear. This tab will provide a copy of the 'Appeals Procedure' to be downloaded. In order to progress to the next stage of the process you will need to 'Opt-In' and complete the 'Form of Acknowledgment' questionnaire and click 'Submit Return' before the Expression of Interest deadline as detailed below.
