



Expressions of Interest

Provision of Biological Database and Mapping Services

The Isle of Man Government invites expressions of interest from organisations or individuals to provide for the continuity of biological database and mapping services to the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture.

We seek tenders for service levels of between 1 and 3 days per week over a 2 year period (please cost for each service level, for 1, 2 and 3 days/week, for which you can provide the service), with potential for extension for a further 3 years. This service is both for the Department and on behalf of the Manx Biological Recording Partnership.

The role will provide a lead and liaison point for the development of the recording and mapping systems and will include the inputting of data and upload to the NBN Atlas Isle of Man. It supports the Department in aiding the wider government to '*Ensure that environmental considerations are embedded across Government decisions and infrastructure*' (Island Plan) and also across the community.

We are looking for someone with a knowledge of ecological data recording, computers and GIS, and to start work as soon as possible, with potential for training by the current provider.

In order to participate in this competitive exercise, your organisation must be registered on the Isle of Man Government's Procurement Portal. Once you have registered your organisation you should select this Quick Quote from the list of 'Current Tenders' and 'View Details' then click 'Express an Interest' at the bottom of the page. Once you have expressed an interest a new tab called 'Quote Documents' will become available where you can download all the necessary information. If you choose to proceed, please select 'Opt In' and a new section will appear for you to upload your completed return documents.

If you decide not to proceed please click 'Opt Out' and select a reason for not proceeding.
