

Request for Information Cashless Catering Solution Ref: GTS/RFI/1002

The Department of Education, Sport and Culture (DESC), Isle of Man Government, wishes to explore the market to refine the requirements for the provision and installation of a cashless catering solution at the Isle of Man secondary schools and college.

The service is required mainly for ordering items off the dinner menu; however, the use could be extended to include purchasing uniforms, paying for trips and more. DESC is also interested in obtaining information on other functions incorporated into cashless catering software to investigate the possible consolidation of services such as online payments and authentication for printing, access and staff time and attendance.
