### **Quick Quote - Electrical Inspection and Testing in compliance with BS7671:2010 to various Isle of Man Schools and Educational Properties.**

The Isle of Man Government invites expressions of interest from Isle of Man Construction Accreditation Scheme (IOMCAS) Electrical Contractors to provide Electrical services to the Department of Infrastructure.

The project comprises the full Inspection and Testing of the whole electrical installation to various educational buildings in compliance with BS7671:2010 with all parts of the installations inspected and tested except areas listed under limitations. Inspection and test to include all items from the MUA supply to point of use, with a full test report to be issued complete with up to date distribution board schedules.

In order to participate in this competitive exercise, your organisation must be registered on the Isle of Man Government's Procurement Portal.
