

Multi Supplier Framework Agreement for the provision of Marine Archaeology Service

Detailed description:

Suitably qualified Tenderers will be appointed from a Multi Party Framework Agreement established for this service to fulfil a specified purpose in the diverse areas where aquaculture is conducted. This expert panel will assist in the delivery of an Underwater Archaeological Impact Assessment (UAIA) that may include all or some of the following services, desktop study, geophysical survey, intertidal / foreshore survey, archaeological dive inspections and could be for aquaculture spanning riverine, estuarine, foreshore and/or subtidal environments.
