Sealed bid will be opened on same day at 11:30 am and top 3 to 5 bidders will be allowed to participate in open auction bid. The highest bid will be considered as successful bidder. GST @ 17% will be charged to successful bidder.			
3	Payment	Remaining 75% amount will have to be paid through pay order within two days.			
4	Delivery / Removal	Lot sold will have to be lifted by the successful bidder at their own expenses within two day after making full payment
