4 RFQ INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 The measurements of the "tender slot" are 320mm wide x 50mm high. Bid responses which are larger than the dimensions mentioned must be split into two or more files and clearly marked. Transnet will not be held responsible if bid documents do not comply with the mentioned dimensions and Respondents experience difficulty in submitting their bids as a result.
- 4.2 It should also be noted that the above tender box is located inside the permit office to the entrance of Transnet at 19 Voortrekker Road, Salt River, Cape Town, 7925 and is accessible to the public from 07:00 am until 16:30 pm.
- 4.3 Proposals must be submitted in duplicate hard copies (1 original and 1 copy) and must be bound.
- 4.4 Sign one set of original documents (sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page) This set will serve as the legal and binding copy. A duplicate set of documents is required. This second set must be a copy of the original signed Proposal.
- 4.5 Both sets of documents are to be submitted to the address specified, and Respondents must ensure that the original and copies (where applicable) are identical in all respects.
- 4.6 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.
- 4.7 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFQ shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.
- 4.8 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. - 6.3 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.
- 6.4 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFQ between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 6.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

7 CONFIDENTIALITY

All information related to this RFQ is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFQ or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.

8 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Supplier/Service provider**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

9 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

10 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFQ and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 10.1 modify the RFQ's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 10.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 10.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 10.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFQ's closing date;

- award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFO;
- 10.6 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 10.7 cancel the bid process;
- 10.8 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;

11 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.

12 SECURITY CLEARANCE

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the Goods/Services and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of **CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET**. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

13 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids. Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.

For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

14 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

SECTION 3: SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1. BACKGROUND

Transnet Engineering (hereinafter referred to as a "client"), one of the five Operating divisions of Transnet Limited (SOC), IS A LEADING South African supplier to the railway industry through manufacturing, upgrading and refurbishment of rolling stock and rolling stock and rail related products. Transnet Engineering's principal objective is to meet and exceed all its commitments and obligations, and the expectations of all its stakeholders, central to delighting its customers, the empowerment of a competent work force and good corporate governance are core values of Transnet Engineering.

Transnet Engineering has a vision of becoming an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) and in becoming an OEM its is vital for SOE to step up the capability of its staff, the trainers that are expected to deliver world class training that is in line with OEM standards of performance.

The Transnet School of Engineering (SOE) IS A WELL-ESTABLISHED AND REPUTABLE Training Institution that focuses on the delivery of various competencies in the Engineering Industry through dedicated leadership, teamwork and experienced facilitators. The school aims to provide skills and relevant competencies in various engineering and functional fields so that employees can perform their duties optimally, safely and fearlessly in any environment where they are called upon.

2. DESCRIPTION OF TRAINING NEEDED

A need has been identified to capacitate TE Personnel working outdoors with knowledge to understand and control dangerous and venomous animals that they typically encounter while working outdoors. The skills will be imparted through formal training that is tailor made and contextualise to the business requirements and that which can also be used in their private daily life.

The identified need should not be addressed solely by knowledge-based interventions but a combination of theoretical and practical interventions.

3. SPECIFICATIONS

- 3.1 The required training should be for the period not more than three (3) consecutive days and should:
- a. Cover content on identifying and understanding dangerous and venomous animals, reptiles, amphibians, bees, spiders, etc. commonly found in the particular area.
- b. Cover content on how to behave when confronted with these species until emergency rescue personnel arrive at the scene.
- c. Learning to be compliment with learning aids/support material such as video clips, etc. to exemplify species' behaviors and required human behavior in confrontational situations.
- d. How to render first aid to a person bitten by venomous animals such as snakes, bees, etc.
- e. Be tailor made as close as possible to Transnet Engineering working environments.
- f. Be NQF aligned (where applicable) and/or an internationally recognized programme (preferably in African countries);
- g. Delivered by qualified facilitator/s and registered Assessor/s and Moderator/s.

NOTE: Training Providers accredited with a relevant quality assurance body such as a SETA: utilizing qualified and experienced trainers will be given preference.

- 3.2 The training provider must develop learning material and waive the intellectual property thereof to Transnet Engineering.
- 3.3 Deliver training and award certificates of competence/completion within a turn-around time not more than two (2) months.
- 3.4 Develop the Learning Programme Evaluation Framework and Tool/s to measure the Learning Programme Return on Investment.
- 3.5 Provide assistance and support to ensure that candidates complete the programme within required time without compromising the quality of training and impart relevant competencies and effective implementation thereof when necessary.
- 3.6 Assist with the development of the written procedure to be followed in cases of emergency situation and provide the closest emergency rescue services' contact details for common species in the surrounding.
- 3.7 Recommend relevant personal protective equipment (PPE) to be procured by Transnet Engineering and worn by employees working in areas where these species exist.
- 3.8 Be willing to update the Transnet Engineering's depository system (IsoMetrix Reports).

4. TARGET GROUP

The targeted audience for these interventions are operational employees working outdoors on various depots of Transnet Engineering, Cape Western Region. Training is to be conducted in these specific 7 depots: Beaufort West, Bellville, Saldanha, Sishen, Voorbaai, Worcester and Salt River.

5. SCOPE

Training is intended for all Transnet Engineering employees at all levels working outdoors. Level of English language complexity and examples should be accommodative to diverse employee groups.

6. COMMENCEMENT

This programme is required urgently to ensure employees' safety in line with Transnet commitment to Health and Safety in the workplace. Therefore, the successful provider will commence with the Intervention as soon as practically possible after signing of the Service Level Agreement (SLA).

7. COSTING STRUCTURE:

Since the proposal cost/price detail list should separately indicate the following where possible:

- Training Material costs.
- Training Delivery costs (per student and/or per group).
- Travelling costs to remote areas (in line with SARS guidelines but not more than R5 per kilometre from trainers' normal place of work).
- Accommodation costs where training is more than a day (limited to two nights)

NOTE: Follow up visits and hidden costs will not be catered for by Transnet Engineering.


