TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROCUREMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF Civil Designer SOFTWARE LICENSES FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS

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1. Background

- 1.1 The Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (DPWI) is seeking to appoint a qualified and experienced service provider to provide and implement Civil Designer Software for DPWI Engineering Services.
- 1.2 The services will be required for the entire DPWI that includes Head Office (Pretoria) and Regional Offices, which are located in all provinces.

2. Business objectives

2.1 To procure and implement the Civil Designer software licenses for the DPWI Engineering Services, with maintenance and support for a period of 12 months.

3. Scope of Work

- 3.1 The appointed service provider will provide the Department with the Civil Designer Software packages on a fixed 12 months term.
- 3.2 The Software Licenses must be perpetual in nature, meaning that the Software will continue to be used by DPWI Engineering Services even after the 12 months contract term has elapsed and DPWI is not under any obligation to renew the Support and Maintenance services with the appointed service provider.
- 3.3 The Department and the appointed service provider will undertake license utilization reconciliation exercises from time to time to ensure maximum and effective software utilization during the 12 months term of contract.


