- **23.2** AsubstantiallyresponsiveBidisonewhichconformstoalltheterms,conditions,andspecificationsof the Bid documents, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservationis one (a) which affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the Works; (b)which limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the Bidding documents, the Employer's rightsor the Bidder's obligations under the Contract; or (c) whose rectification would affect unfairly thecompetitivepositionofotherBidderspresentingsubstantiallyresponsiveBids.
- **23.3** IfaBidisnotsubstantiallyresponsive,itwillberejectedbytheEmployer,andmaynotsubsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal of the non-conforming deviation orreservation.

24. PriceBidOpening

- 24.1 The Tender Inviting Authority (Executive officer)shall notify those bidders whose technicalbids did not meet the minimum qualification criteria or were considered non responsive, indicating that their price bids will be returned un opened after the award of the contract. The Employer shall simultaneously notify the technically qualified bidders indicating the datetime and places etforopening of price bids.
- 24.2 The price bids shall be opened by the **Tender Inviting Authority (Executive officer)**in thepresence of bidders representatives who choose to attend. The name of the bidders, quoted bidprices, discountsoffered ormodification if any shall be read aloud and the **Tender InvitingAuthority(Executiveofficer)**shallprepareminutesofthepricebidopening.

25.1 Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation, and comparison of Bids and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to Biddersorany other persons not officially concerned with such process until the award to the successful Bidder has been announced. Any effort by a Bidder to influence the **Tender Inviting Authority (Executive officer)** processing of Bidsoraward decisions may result in the rejection of his Bid.

26 ClarificationofBids

- 26.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of Bids, bidder may be asked to clarifyBid, including breakdowns of the unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall beinwritingorbycable, butnochangeinthepriceorsubstanceoftheBidshallbesought,offered,orpermitted except as required to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the**TenderScrutinyCommittee**intheevaluationoftheBidsinaccordancewithClause27.
- **26.2** Subject to sub-clause 26.1, no Bidder shall contact the **Employer** or his subordinateson anymatter relating to its bid from the time of the bid opening to the time the contract is awarded.If theBidderwishestobringoutadditionalinformation,itshouldbedoneinwriting.
- **26.3** Any effort by the Bidder to influence the **Tender Inviting Authority (Executive officer)**or anyother person involved in the process of the bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract awarddecisionsmayresult intherejection of the Bidders'bid.

27. CorrectionofErrors

- 27.1 Bids determined to be substantially responsive will be checked by the **Tender Inviting** Authority(Executiveofficer)foranyarithmeticerrors.ErrorswillbecorrectedbytheEmployerasfollows:

27.2 Theamountstated in the Bidwillbead justed by the **TenderInvitingAuthority**(Executiveofficer) in accordance with the above procedure for the correction of errors and, with the concurrence of the Bidder, shall be considered as binding upon the Bidder. Variations, deviations, and alternative offers and otherfactors which are in excess of the requirements of the Bidding documents or otherwiseresult inunsolicitedbenefits fortheEmployershallnotbetakenintoaccountinBidevaluation.
- **28.4.**In respect of the successful tenderer, the EMD remitted along with the tender shall be converted as **SecurityDeposit**. The successful tenderer will be called upontopay for an amount equivalent to 2% of the contract value (which includes 1% Earnest Money Deposit already paid) within 15 days from the receipt of Letter of Acceptance.

<u>F.</u> AwardofContract

29. AwardCriteria

- 29.1 Subject to Clause 31, the employerwill award the Contract to the Bidder whose Bid has beendeterminedtobesubstantiallyresponsivetotheBiddingdocumentsandwhohasofferedthelo west evaluated Bid Price, provided that such Bidder has been determined to be (a) eligible inaccordance with the provisions of Clause 3, and (b) qualified in accordance with the provisions of Clause 4.
- **29.2** The contractor, shall note that the Joint venture is not permitted under this contract and also Subcontractingisnotpermitted.

30. Employer'sRighttoAcceptanyBidandtoRejectanyorallBids

- **30.1** Notwithstanding Clause 29, the Town Panchayat Executive officer reservesthe right to accept orreject anyBid,andtocanceltheBiddingprocess andrejectallBids,atanytimepriortotheaward ofContract,withouttherebyincurringanyliabilitytotheaffectedBidderorBiddersoranyobligationtoinformth eaffectedBidderorBiddersofthegroundsfortheEmployer'saction.
- 30.2 NegotiationofrateswillbemadeonlywiththelowestBidderforreducingthequotedrates

31. NotificationofAwardandSigningofAgreement

- **31.1** TheBidderwhoseBidhasbeenacceptedwillbenotifiedoftheawardpriortoexpiryoftheBidvalidityperiodb ycable,telexorfacsimileconfirmedbyregisteredletter.Thisletter(hereinafterandintheConditionsofCont ractcalled the"LetterofAcceptance")will statethesumthatwill bepaidtotheContractorinconsiderationoftheexecution,completion,andmaintenanceoftheWorksbythe ContractorasprescribedbytheContract(hereinafterandintheContractcalledthe"ContractPrice").
- **31.2** ThenotificationofawardwillconstitutetheformationoftheContract,subjectonlytothefurnishingofansecuri tydepositinaccordancewiththeprovisionsofClause28.4.

- **31.3** The Agreement will incorporate all terms and conditions to be executed between the employer and successful bidder. It shall be signed within 15 days following the issue of Letter of Acceptance and delivered by successful bidder.
- **31.4** UponthefurnishingbythesuccessfulBidderoftheSecurityDeposit,ifanytheExecutiveofficerwillpromptly notifytheotherBiddersthattheirBidshavebeenunsuccessful.

32. CorruptorFraudulentPractices

3. LanguageandLaw

4. Engineer'sDecisions

5. Delegation

8. Personnel

The **Executive officer** will approve anyproposed replacement of key personnel only iftheir qualifications, abilities, and relevantexperience are substantially equal to or better than those of the personnel listed in theSchedule.
- 8.2 If the **Executive officer** asks the Contractor to remove a person who is a member of the Contractor's staff or his work force stating the reasons the Contractor shall ensure that the person leaves the Site within seven days and has no further connection with the work in the Contract.

13. TheworkstobeCompletedbytheIntendedCompletionDate

13.1 The Contractor maycommence execution of the Works on the Start Date and shall carry outtheWorksinaccordancewiththeprogramandcompletethework asfollows.

15. Safety

15.1 TheContractorshallberesponsibleforthesafetyofallactivitiesontheSite.

16. Discoveries

16.1 Anything of historical or other interest or of significant value unexpectedly discovered on theSite is the property of the Employer. The Contractor is to notify the **Executive officer** of suchdiscoveriesandcarryoutthe**Executiveofficer's**instructionsfordealingwiththem.

17. AccesstotheSite

17.1 The Contractor shall allow the **Executive officer** and any person authorized by the AssistantExecutiveEngineer access to the Site, to any place where work in connection with theContract is being carried out or is intended to be carried out and to any place where materialsorplantarebeingmanufactured/fabricated/ assembledfortheworks.

18. Instructions

18.1 The Contractor shall carry out all instructions of the **Executive officer**, which comply with theapplicablelawswheretheSiteislocated.

B. TimeControl

19. Program

- 19.1 Within the time stated in the Clause 13 of Section 2, the Contractor shall submit to theEngineer for approval a Program showing the general methods, arrangements, order, andtimingforalltheactivitiesintheWorksalongwithmonthlycashflowforecast.
- 19.2 An update of the Program shall be a program showing the actual progress achieved on eachactivity and the effect of the progress achieved on the timing of the remaining work includinganychangestothesequenceof theactivities.
- 19.3 The Contractor shallsubmit to the **Executive officer**, for approval, an updated Program atintervals no longer than the period stated in the Clause 13 of Section 2. If the Contractor doesnot submit an updated Program within this period, the **Executive officer**may withhold theamount stated in the Clause 31 of Section 2 from the next payment certificate and continue towithhold this amount until the next payment after the date on which the overdue Program hasbeensubmitted.
- 19.4 The **Executive officer**'s approval of the Program shall not alter the Contractor's obligations. The Contractor may revise the Program and submit it to the Engineer again at any time. ArevisedProgramis toshowtheeffectofVariationsandCompensationEvents.

20. DelaysOrderedbytheEmployer

20.1 The **Executiveofficer** mayinstruct the Contractor to delay the start or progress of any activity within the Works.

21. ManagementMeetings

- 21.1 Either the **Executive officer** or the Contractor may require the other to attend a managementmeeting. The business of a management meeting shall be to review the plans for remainingworkandtodealwithmattersraisedinaccordancewiththeearlywarningprocedure.
- 21.2 The **Executive officer** shall record the business of management meetings and is to provide opies of his record to those attending the meeting and to the Employer. The responsibility of the parties for actions to be taken is to be decided by the **Executive officer** either at themanagement meeting or after the management meeting and stated in writing to all whoattended the meeting.

22. EarlyWarning

- 22.1 The Contractor is to warn the **Executive officer** at the earliest opportunity of specific likelyfuture events or circumstances that may adversely affect the quality of the work, increase theContractPriceordelaytheexecutionof works.
- 22.2 TheContractorshallcooperatewiththe **Executiveofficer**inmakingandconsideringproposals for how the effect of such an event or circumstance can be avoidedor reduced by any one involved in the work and incarrying out any resulting instruction of the Engineer.

C. QualityControl

23. IdentifyingDefects

 - 23.3 ThecontractorshallpermittheStateQualitymonitoringAgencytocheckthecontractor'sworkand notify the **Assistant Engineer/Junior Engineer** andContractor ofany defects that arefound.Such a check shallnot affect theContractor's or theEngineer's responsibility asdefinedintheContractAgreement

24. Tests

24.1 If the **AssistantEngineer/JuniorEngineer**instructs the Contractor to carry out at est not specifie d in the Specification to check whether any work has a Defect and the test shows that it does, the Contractor shall pay for the test and any samples. If there is no Defect the test shall be a Compensation Event.

25. CorrectionofDefects

25.1 The **Executiveofficer**shall give notice to the Contractor of any Defects before the end of the Defects Liability Period, which begins at Completion and is defined in the Clause 31 of

Section 2. The Defects Liability Period shall be extended for as long as Defects remain tobecorrected.
