Dear Bidders,

- 1. **Scope**: Sealed tenders are invited by NCC Directorate (TN,P&AN) Fort St George, Chennai 600 009 hereinafter referred as "Govt/Auctioneer" from Bidder/Buyer/ Contractor hereinafter referred to as "Bidder/Tenderer" for selling/disposal of Condemned Vehicle TATA Indigo on "As is Where is Condition". The details of vehicle are given as appendix 'A'
- 2. **Tender document:** : Tenderers may downloads documents from the internet on free of cost from 17.05.2022 onwards. Tender documents are not supplied/issued in person. Filled-in tender forms, along with the required EMD, shall be submitted to NCC Dte (TN,P&AN), Fort St George, Chennai - 600 009. Offers once given shall not be allowed to be withdrawn under any circumstances, whatsoever, irrespective of whether such withdrawal is before or after the opening of the tender. Incomplete tenders or tenders received without all the requisite enclosures or tenders not in accordance with the tender terms and conditions will be summarily rejected. Tenders who have submitted tender forms before 11.00 a.m. on 24.05.2022 alone should be eligible to participate in the Auction - cum- Tender. The closing date and time for submission of tender forms for tender is 24.05.2022, upto 11.00 A.M. Tenderers are not allowed to submit the tender forms beyond the stipulated date and time.
- 3. **EMD**: A sum of Rs. Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) should be submitted by means of Demand Draft in favour of ".NCC Directorate (TN,P&AN)", payable at "Chennai" while submitting tender. In the case of successful tenderers, the EMD amount will be retained as interest free Security Deposit and will be refunded after taking delivery of the condemned vehicle. Tender documents received without a Demand Draft of Rs.500/- will be summarily rejected. The Earnest Money Deposit will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers at the expenses of the tenderers within a reasonable time.
- 4. **Value**.: The minimum fetch value fixed by the Motor Vehicle Maintenance Department is Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) plus taxes applicable. The vehicle will not be sold below the fetch value i.e Rs.25,000/-. Rate quoted should be exclusive of all applicable taxes. The tenderer should remit the current ruling GST while taking delivery together with the cost of the Condemned Vehicle to be finalised by NCC Dte (TN,P&AN) after all the tender processes are over as may be decided by NCC Dte (TN,P&AN) then and there.

- 5. **Validity**: The highest rate to be quoted by the tenderer in the bid / offered by the tenderer in the tender should be valid for a period of 2 months from the date of Tender/Auction held and NCC Dte (TN,P&AN) reserves the right to either accept or reject the rate upto a period of 3 months. Rate should be quoted only in Indian Currency both in words and figures. In case of variations between the two, higher rate alone will be taken into consideration.
- 6. **Opening of Tenders**: The sealed tenders will be opened by the Board of Officers duly convened for that purpose, or any other Officers, authorised by NCC Dte (TN,P&AN) on his behalf on the same day (i.e. 24.05.2022) at 1130 hrs NCC Dte (TN,P&AN), Chennai in the presence of such of those tenderers or their representatives who present at the time of opening. The representatives of the Tendering firms who are attending the opening of the tenders should bring a letter of authority from the tendering Firms, duly identifying their bonafide on behalf of which they represent. The tenders received either by post / by courier or in person after the time specified for the receipt of the filled in tender shall not be considered under any circumstances, whatsoever it may be. Tenders should be superscribed as "AUCTION OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE "AS IS WHERE IS CONDITION" AT NCC DIRECTORATE (TN,P&AN), FORT ST GEORGE, CHENNAI 09."
- 7. **Inspection**: The Bidders who are desirous, if any, for inspection of the vehicle, may inspect on all working days between 1100 hrs and 1700 hrs.
- 8. **Payment**: The highest Bidder who quotes highest value among the competitive Bidders will be selected as H1 Bidder./Successful Bidder. The cost of the Bid amount along with taxes should be remitted to the relevant Government account within five days.
- 9. **Delivery**: After remittance of the bid amount along with the taxes applicable, the vehicle will be delivered to the successful H1 Bidder along with 'G' surrender certificate..
- 10. **Decision of NCC Directorate:** Dy DG NCC shall have the right to accept or reject or cancel any or all the tenders and postpone the date of Auction cumTender without assigning any reasons, there for, and that the decision of the Dy DG NCC shall be the final and binding on the tenderers.
