We have vast experience in supplying IT, Mobility, and electronics solutions to organizations and equip them with leading technologies. We have also worked with government and NGOs in India and abroad. We came across an ongoing Request for Proposal RFP UBI/DIT/2022-23/13 by Union Bank of India for the procurement of 50 nos of MacBooks Pro. We strongly believe that the RFP needs to be cancelled and should be republished on GeM portal in an unprejudiced manner. The valid point to point explanations for the same are mentioned below:  The RFP is against the clauses of 'Make in India'. We believe that a well reputed bank like Union Bank of India which is a bank of national importance should come forward to promote and support Make in India initiative. But as per RFP, the bank wants to promote such devices which are majorly manufactured in a country sharing land border with India. The RFP is in violation of Make in India guidelines because the MacBook Pro is not a Class I or Class I product.  We recommend the inclusion of Class I product which has more than 50% of local manufactured content. This will contribute on the promotion of Make in India with best-in-class manufacturing infrastructure in the country.  A sper the RFP document, there must be atleast 5 service center in all five zones of India. Which means one service center each in North, South, East, West, and Central India. These zones share large geographical areas where it takes 24hours - 48hours to reach from one point to another in the same zone. There will be problem in assistance of services. By doing this RFP is setting structure in a way that the chances of any problems during service delivery is quiet.  Adding to the above point, Pan India availability of authorized Apple service center is still not present. If any assistance in services is needed, then end user will be at problem because of poor accessibility of service centers. Five service center will not be | Please be guided by RFP   |

| 3 | Our organization would like you intervene in the RFP - UBI/DIT/2022-23/13 Date: 14-06-2022 at 11:00 Hours by Department of Information Technology – Union Bank of India, where offers are invited for Supply, Installation & Maintenance of MacBook Pro with 2 Years Apple Care Pack under Rate Contract to be delivered across 18 zonal offices and Central Offices of Union Bank and which in numerous ways points to the unfair practices in the tendering process. Below, we have listed points that we as an organization have found to be of serious concern and should be rectified on utmost priority.  This tender is released on a third party private tendering platform 'abcprocure.com' which operates under the umbrella of an organization 'procuretiger.com' (e-Procurement Technologies Limited (ETL)). This organization provides procurement solutions to private enterprises. But for public procurement by any bank GeM Portal is the central procurement platform and is the only authorized body for releasing tenders. All the guidelines by GeM are now applicable to all the procurement(s) by any government body in India and thus for the integrity of the GoI norms this tender should be immediately cancelled and should be re-tendered on GeM with the below listed amendments. It is quite concerning that in spite of numerous Government-led initiatives to promote Make in India initiative and local manufacturing, Union Bank has released this tender exclusively for a product and its OEM which flouts every possible statutory requirement and effort to promote Indian based manufacturers, in this case MacBook Pro by Apple corporation. Apple uses contract manufacturers to produce its devices in China. For example, companies like Foxconn, Pegatron, and Wistron employ hundreds of thousands of workers to assemble Apple devices in China. It is ironical that the very same brand, which is neither aligned with Government procurement conditions, nor sells in any Government institution due to its resistance to local indian manufacturing is being promoted by Un | Please be guided by RFP |
